CLARIFICATORY ORDER

Dated: September 7, 2007

The Commission passed an Order dated April 30, 2007 (Case No. 70 of 2006) in the matter of Determination of Annual Revenue Requirement for the Control Period from FY 2007-08 to FY 2009-10 under MYT and tariff for FY 2007-08 for M/s. Tata Power Company Ltd. The fourth paragraph of the approved Low Tension Tariff schedule placed in Appendix 4 [Page No. 84] of the Order stipulates the applicability of LT IV tariff as follows:

“LT IV: Advertisements and Hoardings

Applicability

Electricity used for purpose of advertisements, hoardings and other conspicuous consumption such as external flood light, displays, neon signs at departmental stores, malls, multiplexes, theatres, clubs, hotels and other such entertainment / leisure establishments except those specifically covered under LT-II or LT-III as well as electricity used for the external illuminations of monumental, historical / heritage buildings approved by MTDC, which shall be covered under LT-II or LT-III category depending upon Sanctioned Load”.

2. For the purpose of the paragraph quoted above, it is clarified that the electricity that is used for the purpose of indicating / displaying the name and other details of the shops or commercial premises, for which electric supply is rendered, shall not be under LT IV Tariff Category. Such usage of electricity shall be covered under the prevailing tariff of such shops or commercial premises.
