PRACTICE DIRECTIONS
REGARDING REVIEW OF OWN ORDERS BY CGRFs

MERC (CONSUMER GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL FORUM AND ELECTRICITY OMBUDSMAN) REGULATIONS, 2006

Preamble

It has been brought to the notice of the Commission that a Consumer Grievance Redressal

Forum (CGRF) has entertained applications made by a Distribution Licensee for review of its

own Orders. While there is a specific provision for review by the Electricity Ombudsman, the

MERC (CGRF and Electricity Ombudsman) Regulations, 2006 do not empower CGRFs to

review their own Orders. Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Regulation 26

of the Regulations, the Commission issues the following Practice Directions:

Practice Directions

1. The CGRFs are directed not to entertain applications from any party seeking review

of their own Orders.

2. If any instance of a CGRF entertaining such an application or reviewing its own Order

comes to his notice, the Electricity Ombudsman may suo moto call for the papers and

give appropriate directions.

3. A consumer may take recourse to the Electricity Ombudsman if a CGRF reviews its

own Order upon an application made by a Distribution Licensee, or entertains such an

application.
